Literacy

To learn the spellings from the Year 2 list as found in the pupil reading record booklet.

Writing –

To write in clear sentences using capital letters and full stops accurately.

To re-read own writing and to check for sense.

To plan and write simple stories with a clear beginning, middle and end.

Reading – To read aloud with expression.
Please remember that daily reading at home is essential.

To understand

To learn pairs of numbers that make 20, e.g. 17+ 3.

Adding two 2-digit numbers.

To understand multiplication and division whilst solving word problems.
