- Children with statemented special educational needs or children for whom a formal statutory assessment has been agreed.
- Children who live within the area served by the school, who are in social, medical or developmental need according to the Borough Council’s children-in need categories. Children offered places under this category are likely to be strongly supported by doctors, health visitors or social workers.
- Children who live nearest to the school as defined in the school’s own publicity, with priority given to those who live in the area by the school.
